VISA CHECKLIST

WORKING HOLIDAY VISA

In order to lodge an appointment, applicants are required to attempt to book an appointment using the PRENOT@MI application available on our website.

REQUIREMENTS	CHECK
1 Applicants must be citizens of New Zealand living in New Zealand.	
2 Satisfy the visa officer that his/her primary intention is to holiday in Italy, with employment being an incidental rather than primary reason for the visit.	
3 Aged between 18 and 30, inclusive, at the time of application.	
4 Not include any minor dependants on the application.	
5 Never obtained a WHV to Italy before.	
6 The applicant must enter Italy within 3 months from the date of issue of the visa.	

DOCUMENTS	CHECK
1 Printed and completed National Visa Application Form .	
2 Current passport with at least 3 months' residual validity after the visa expiry date (the passport must have 2 blank pages on which the visa will be affixed).	
3 1 recent passport-size photo. ICAO	
4 Full flight itinerary including border of entry into Italy. WITH Return-trip booking from/to NZ for Schengen Visa Applications (short stay).	
5 Travel insurance: minimum coverage of €30,000 for medical reasons, emergency hospital, repatriation expenses including for body remains, valid for all Schengen countries and for the whole duration of the stay in the Schengen area policy (ONLY from European and local NZ insurance companies).	
6 Proof of Payment of the visa processing fee (i.e., screenshot of your bank account). Payment is required by bank transfer. Please note that the amount of the visa processing fee changes from quarter to quarter, details here (please pay amount for National Visa).	
7 Prepaid self-addressed courier envelope with attached "Courier with Signature" label (to be purchased separately). For Rural deliveries please include also a "Rural Delivery label" (also purchased separately).	
8 Proof of sufficient funds to support the stay in Italy (Direttiva del Ministero dell'Interno del 1.3.2000, artt. 2 e 4). This requirement is compulsory even when all travel expenses have already been paid for.
